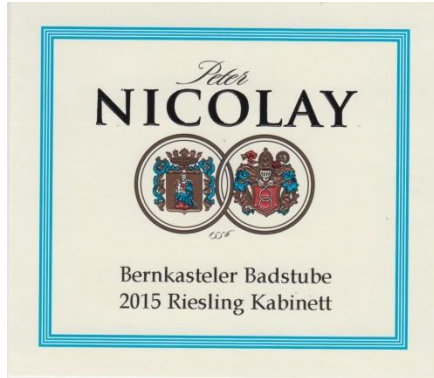

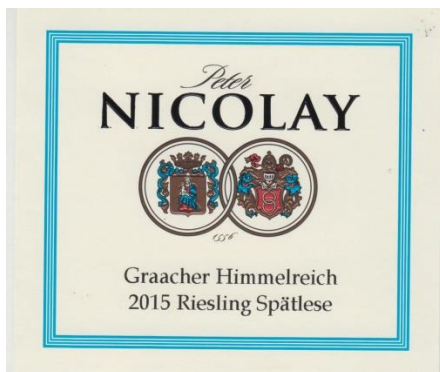

**92 points**

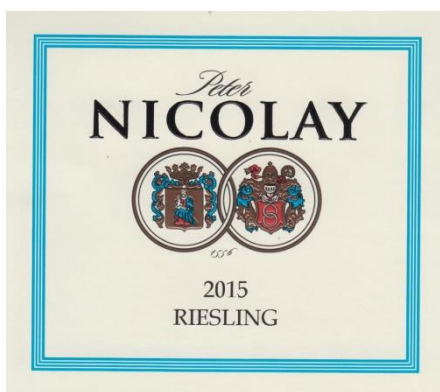
While intensely fruity, a deep vein of crushed-slate minerality extends from nose to finish in this lithe Kabinett. Lip-smacking honey and peach flavors penetrate through the palate, electrified by a laser of lemon-lime acidity. Finishes remarkably dry and fresh.

Creamy and plush, with concentrated peach and apricot flavors that are well-spiced. Some honeyed notes show on the broad finish. Drink now through 2022. 200 cases made. *-KM*



**Wine Spectator**

**88 points**

A fruity white, with flavors of red berry, red plum and apple that are well-spiced. Redolent of peach cobbler on the juicy finish. Drink now. 2,000 cases made. *-KM*

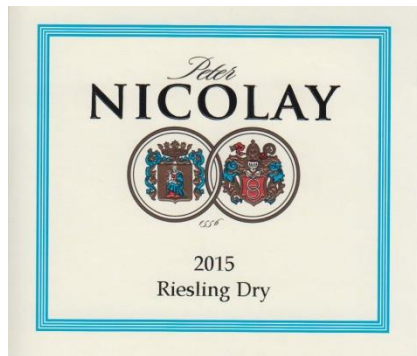


**87 points**

The nose of this light-footed quaffer is subdued, suggesting notes of lime, lemon and waxy apple skin. Squirts of fresh apple and pear are juicy and thirst-quenching on the palate. Off-dry in style, it's pleasantly honeyed, but balanced by subtle herb tones and a refreshingly tart lemon finish. Drink now through 2018.

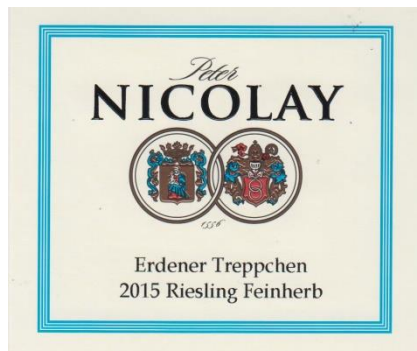

Bright tangerine and honey notes lend a sunny demeanor to this voluptuously dry Riesling. Ripe grapefruit and lemon flavors penetrate through the palate, finishing on a steely tang of acid and minerals

Dusty mineral and slate notes juxtapose ripe pineapple, honey and yellow cherry flavors in this zingy-fresh Riesling. Harmoniously off-dry in style, it's approachable yet finessed.
